Saint-Etienne-de-Crossey has a municipal campground with 10 spacious and shaded sites. It is open from mid-June to mid-September.

It is equipped with a PMR access, sanitary facilities for the whole family (including baby area), 220V electrical outlets and a free emptying station reserved for motor homes.

## Opening hours of the reception:

Every day from June to September from 8am to 11am In July and August: from 8am to 11am and from 6pm to 8pm Outside the opening hours of the reception, the access remains possible to new campers
